**Approval of Commission Minutes**

## **Julie Schottman-Discuss Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFO)**

Julie Schottman came before the Commission with information on CAFO – Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations. She would like the Commission to consider a health ordinance specifically for CAFO. County Counsel William McCullah stated the County has a Livestock Confinement Operations (LCO) already in place. The Commission will look over the LCO and if any changes need to be made, they will amend it on August 20<sup>th</sup> at 10:00AM.

Presiding Commissioner Mark Maples, gave time for anyone who would like to speak for or against this issue. Several concerned citizens came forward regarding the Health Ordinance for CAFO.
